ELEMENTS & PRINCIPLES OF ART

LINE

Line is the path of a point moving through space.



SHAPE / FORM




Shape implies spatial form and is usually perceived as two-dimensional. Form has depth, length, and width and resides in space. It is perceived as three-dimensional.

COLOR



VALUE



TEXTURE



SPACE / PERSPECTIVE



PATTERN

Pattern refers to the repetition or reoccurrence of a design element, exact or varied, which establishes a visual beat.



RHYTHM / MOVEMENT

Rhythm or movement refers to the suggestion of motion through the use of various elements.



PROPORTION / SCALE

Proportion is the size relationship of parts to a whole and to one another. Scale refers to relating size to a constant, such as a human body.



BALANCE

Balance is the impression of equilibrium in a pictorial or sculptural composition. Balance is often referred to as symmetrical, asymmetrical, or radial.



UNITY

Unity is achieved when the components of a work of art are perceived as harmonious, giving the work a sense of completion.



EMPHASIS

Emphasis refers to the created center of interest, the place in an artwork where your eye first lands.

Animal Prints


Estampado Animal

Animal print is a clothing and fashion style in which the garment is made to resemble the pattern of the skin and fur, feathers or scales of animals such as a leopard, zebra, giraffe, tiger or cow. Animal print is also used for room decoration, handbags and footwear and even some jewelry.

More solid spots which are not arranged into rosettes






Ditsy

A Ditsy print is a **very small scale all-over pattern with a random look, not linear or geometric**. Flowers are often depicted, but are not exclusively used.




Artist of the Day: Josef Frank



- Lived 1885 – 1967
- Josef was an Architect and Designer (this can be called total design, when the architect of a house or building also designs the interior furniture and wallpaper decorations)
- Born in Austria, Josef Frank and his family emigrated to Sweden to escape the Nazis in 1933
- Father of Swedish Modernism
- His work paved the way for the likes of Ikea and Marimekko
- "Lagom" is a Swedish word, meaning "just enough" which Frank's work stretches and typifies :)

Artista del día: Josef Frank



- Vivió 1885 – 1967
- Josef fue arquitecto y diseñador (esto se puede llamar diseño total, cuando el arquitecto de una casa o edificio también diseña los muebles interiores y las decoraciones de papel tapiz)
- Nacido en Austria, Josef Frank y su familia emigraron a Suecia para escapar de los nazis en 1933.
- Padre del modernismo sueco
- Su trabajo allanó el camino para empresas como Ikea y Marimekko.
- "Lagom" es una palabra sueca, que significa "lo suficiente", que el trabajo de Frank estira y tipifica :)



Pattern Project #1: Proyecto de patrón #1:

Things to consider: Aspectos a tener en cuenta:

- How does color affect what season the floral will be associated with?

Direction: Omni-directional (pattern elements are oriented in multiple ways)


Audience: 16 – 22 yr. Olds who have cottage-core inspired pinterest boards and enjoy camping



A Note on the Importance of Planning - Una nota sobre la importancia de la planificación -

This pattern and the pattern that precedes it have the same basic building blocks. However, I didn't thumbnail out the previous pattern or do any real planning other than brief visual research for reference photos and a quick theme brainstorm (woodland vibes of mushrooms, frogs, and acorns). As a result, even though there are some things I really liked about the previous pattern, it came out feeling sloppy and disjointed. Sometimes you need to start over and that's ok!! I think the pattern came out much better the second time around. I don't ask you to do all this planning and thinking to frustrate you, it's to help you avoid this mistake :)

Este patrón y el patrón que lo precede tienen los mismos bloques de construcción básicos. Sin embargo, no hice una miniatura del patrón anterior ni hice ninguna planificación real que no sea una breve investigación visual para fotos de referencia y una rápida lluvia de ideas sobre temas (vibraciones boscosas de hongos, ranas y bellotas). Como resultado, a pesar de que hay algunas cosas que realmente me gustaron del patrón anterior, salió sintiéndose descuidado y desarticulado. ¡A veces necesitas empezar de nuevo y eso está bien! Creo que el patrón salió mucho mejor la segunda vez. No te pido que hagas toda esta planificación y pensamiento para frustrarte, es para ayudarte a evitar este error :)

Artist of the Day: William Morris



- Lived 1834 – 1896
- British textile designer, poet, artist, fantasy writer, architectural conservationist, printer, translator and socialist activist associated with the British Arts and Crafts Movement
- He was a major contributor to the revival of traditional British textile arts and methods of production
- His literary contributions helped to establish the modern fantasy genre, while he helped win acceptance of socialism in fin de siècle Great Britain.

Artista del Dia: William Morris



- Vivió entre 1834 y 1896
- Diseñador textil británico, poeta, artista, escritor de fantasía, conservacionista arquitectónico, impresor, traductor y activista socialista asociado con el Movimiento Británico de Artes y Oficios
- Fue un importante contribuyente al renacimiento de las artes textiles tradicionales británicas y los métodos de producción
- Sus contribuciones literarias ayudaron a establecer el género de fantasía moderna, mientras que ayudó a ganar la aceptación del socialismo en la Gran Bretaña de fin de siglo.
